

Reduction of Social Security Fund Contribution Rates

Due to the on-going COVID-19 pandemic, on 23rd June 2021, the Thailand Government enacted a Royal Decree to reduce the rates of the contributions which the self-insured persons must pay to the Social Security Fund under the Social Security Act B.E. 2533 each month for a period of 6 months from 1st August 2021 to 31st January 2022.

The reduced contribution rates and the rates after the 6-month period are summarized as follows:

No.	Grounds of Benefits for Self-Insured Persons	Reduced Rates of Contributions 1 st August 2021 to 31 st January 2022 (THB)	Rates of Contributions from 1 st February 2022 (THB)
1.	- injury or sickness - disability - death	42	70
2.	- injury or sickness - disability - death - old-age	60	120
3.	- injury or sickness - disability - death - old-age - child support	180	300
